SUBJECT CONFIRMATION

GRADE 10 - 12

The National Senior Certificate (NSC) spans Grades 10, 11 and 12, and is a Level 4 qualification on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF). The NSC requires that students take a minimum of 7 subjects, including the 4 compulsory subjects and 3 electives from Groups B and C).

For admission to a Bachelor's Degree pass with:

- at least 40% in Home Language
- at least 50% for four other high credit subjects (e.g. maths, science, physics, biology, geography, economics, accounting)
- at least 30% for two other subjects (e.g. tourism, CAT, Business Studies)
